The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows

1 Section 1 Sections 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 and 9 act of June 1 1956 (P L 1959)

10 SECTION 2 THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE CHIEF
11 JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT SHALL BE [THIRTY]

1 [THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$30,500)] THIRTY-
2 THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$33,000) AND THE ANNUAL
3 SALARY OF EACH OF THE ASSOCIATE JUDGES OF THE
4 SUPREME COURT SHALL BE [THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS
5 (\$30,000)] THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOL-
6 LARS (\$32,500)

7 SECTION 3 THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE PRESIDENT
8 JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT SHALL BE [TWENTY-
9 EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$28,500)]
10 THIRTY-ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$31,000) AND THE AN-
11 NUAL SALARY OF EACH OF THE ASSOCIATE JUDGES OF
12 THE SUPERIOR COURT SHALL BE [TWENTY-EIGHT THOU-
13 SAND DOLLARS (\$28,000)] THIRTY THOUSAND FIVE HUN-
14 DRED DOLLARS (\$30,500)

15 Section 4 [The annual salary of each of the judges of the courts of
16 common pleas of the first and fifth judicial districts shall be twenty-
17 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500)]

18 With the exception of the judges of the courts of common pleas of
19 Dauphin County the annual salary of each of the judges of the courts
20 of common pleas learned in the law in judicial districts having a popula-

2 one million] inhabitants shall be [twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000)]
3 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in judicial districts having a
4 population of one hundred thousand and more but less than [two]
5 one hundred fifty thousand inhabitants shall be [twenty thousand dol-
6 lars (\$20,000)] twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500) in
7 judicial districts having a population of ~~sixty-five thousand or more~~ and
8 less than one hundred thousand inhabitants shall be [nineteen thousand
9 dollars (\$19,000)] twenty-one thousand five hundred dollars (\$21,500)

15 000) IN JUDICIAL DISTRICTS HAVING A POPULATION OF
16 LESS THAN SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND INHABITANTS EIGHT-
17 EEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000)] TWENTY-ONE THOU-
18 SAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$21,500) The amount of the
19 salaries to be paid under this paragraph in the several judicial districts~~

1 shall be determined and fixed according to the population of such dis-
2 tricts as ascertained by reference from time to time to the last preceding
3 decennial United States census

4 Section 5 The judges of the courts of common pleas of Dauphin
5 County and the judges of the orphans' court of Dauphin County shall
6 each receive [twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)] twenty-seven
7 thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500) annually

8 Section 6 In any county where a separate orphans' court is es-
9 tablished the annual salary of each judge of the orphans' court shall
10 be the same as is paid to the judge or judges of the court or courts
11 of common pleas in such county

12 Section 7 The annual salary of the President Judge of the Munic-
13 ipal Court of Philadelphia shall be [eighteen thousand five hundred
14 dollars (\$18,500)] twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000) and the
15 annual salary of each of the other judges of the Municipal Court of
16 Philadelphia shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)] twenty-two
17 thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500)

18 Section 8 The annual salary of the President Judge of the County
19 Court of Allegheny County shall be [eighteen thousand five hundred]

1 [dollars (\$18,500)] twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000) and the an-
2 nual salary of each of the other judges of the County Court of Allegheny
3 County shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)] twenty-two thou-
4 sand five hundred dollars (\$22,500)

5 Section 9 The annual salary of the judge of the Juvenile Court of
6 Allegheny County shall be [eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)]
7 twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500)

8 Section 2 This act shall take effect ~~immediately~~ JULY 1 1962
