No. 1.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, approved the twenty-fourth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, two hundred and ninety-seven), entitled "An act authorizing the establishment of contagious disease hospitals in the several counties of the Commonwealth, to be constructed and maintained out of county funds," providing for the establishment and maintenance of contagious disease hospitals by two or more counties jointly.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That whenever the County Commissioners of two or more counties decide that a hospital for the care of contagious diseases is necessary, they may join in establishing such hospital, either on the grounds of the county poor-farm of either county, or on such other suitable location agreed on as may be purchased for the purpose, subject, however, in all other respects to the conditions and limitations prescribed by the act to which this is a supplement.

Contagious disease hospitals.

Two or more counties may join in establishing.

Subject to act of May 24, 1917. (P. L. 297.)

Section 2. Such joint hospitals shall be conducted and maintained under the joint authority of the directors of the poor of the counties joining in the establishment thereof.

Joint authority of directors of the poor.

All expenses incident to the construction and maintenance of such contagious disease hospitals shall be borne jointly by the counties establishing the same in such proportions as may be agreed on by the county commissioners.

Expenses of construction and maintenance.

AN ACT

To amend section two of the act approved the eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and forty-eight), entitled "An act providing for the joint acquisition and maintenance by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey of certain toll bridges over the Delaware River," as amended.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two of the act approved the eighth day of May, one thousand

nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and forty-eight), entitled "An act providing for the joint acquisition and maintenance by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey of certain toll bridges over the Delaware River," as amended by the act approved the twentieth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and ninety-six), entitled "An act to amend section two of the act approved the eighth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and forty-eight), entitled 'An act providing for the joint acquisition and maintenance by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey of certain toll bridges over the Delaware River,'" is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The [Board of Commissioners of Public Grounds and Buildings] *Auditor General, State Treasurer, and Secretary of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania*, and two citizens of the Commonwealth to be appointed by the Governor, are hereby constituted a Commission to act in conjunction with a similar Commission of the State of New Jersey, as a joint Commission for the acquisition of the various toll bridges over the Delaware River between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New Jersey.

No. 3.

AN ACT

To amend section one thousand and six, of the act approved the eighteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and eleven (Pamphlet Laws, three hundred nine), entitled "An act to establish a public school system in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, together with the provisions by which it shall be administered, and prescribing penalties for the violation thereof; providing revenue to establish and maintain the same, and the method of collecting such revenue; and repealing all laws, general, special or local, or any parts thereof, that are or may be inconsistent therewith;" requiring the Superintendent of Public Instruction to send to every school director a copy of each new edition of the School Code.
