Section 2. The [Board of Commissioners of Public State Treasurer rounds and Buildings] Auditor General, State Treasurer and Secretary of Highways consti-Grounds and Buildings] Auditor General, State Treasurer, and Secretary of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania [is] are hereby constituted a commission, to act, in conjunction with a similar commission of the State of New York, or with any other governmental agency designated by the State of New York, as a joint commission, for the acquisition of the various bridges over the Delaware River between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of New York.
