## AN ACT

To repeal section nine of an act, approved the eighth day of July, one thousand nine hundred nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, seven hundred seventy), entitled "An act creating a Division of Township Highways in the State Highway Department; conferring powers, and imposing duties upon officers of the State Highway Department, requiring certain duties of clerks of the courts of quarter sessions; and providing penalties."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section nine of an act, approved the eighth day of July, one thousand nine hundred nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, seven hundred seventy), entitled "An act creating a Division of Township Highways in the State Highway Department; conferring powers, and imposing duties upon officers of the State Highway Department; requiring certain duties of clerks of the courts of quarter sessions; and providing penalties," be and the same is hereby repealed.

## AN ACT

To further amend section seven hundred twenty-seven of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the laws relating thereto," as amended, by providing for the Department of Highways to decentralize to townships of the first class; and when so authorized township to collect and retain fees.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section seven hundred and twenty-seven of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto," as amended by an act, approved June fourteenth, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three (Pamphlet Laws, seven hundred and seventy-three), is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 727. No railroad or street railway shall hereafter be constructed upon any township highway, nor shall any railroad or street railway crossing, nor any gas pipe, water pipe, electric conduits, or other piping be laid upon or in, nor shall any telephone, tele-
