AN ACT

To amend section two of the act, approved the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, six hundred seventy), entitled "An act defining cold storage, and regulating time of storage of certain articles of food, and providing penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act," by exempting State-owned institutions operating cold-storage warehouses from the payment of license fees.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two of the act, approved the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, six hundred seventy), entitled "An act defining cold-storage, and regulating time of storage of certain articles of food, and providing penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. No person, firm, or corporation shall maintain or operate a cold-storage warehouse without a license so to do issued by the [Director of the Bureau of Foods.] *Department of Agriculture*. Any person, firm, or corporation, desiring such a license, shall make written application to the [Director of the Bureau of Foods] *department* for that purpose, stating the location of the warehouse.

The [Director of the Bureau of Foods] *department* thereupon shall cause an examination to be made of said warehouse, and, if it be found [by him] to be in a proper sanitary condition and otherwise properly equipped for its intended use, [he] *the department* shall issue a license authorizing the applicant to operate the same as a cold-storage warehouse during one year; the license shall be issued upon payment by the applicant of a license fee of fifty dollars (\$50) to the [Director of the Bureau of Foods,] *department*, and shall thereafter be *paid* by the [Director of the Bureau of Foods *paid*] *department* into the State Treasury, through the *Department of Revenue*, for the use of the Commonwealth: *Provided, That no license fee shall be charged for the issuance of such license to any State-owned institution operating a cold-storage warehouse.*
