

Interstate Legislative Reference Bureau, established by the American Legislators' Association to coordinate the work of the various state legislative reference bureaus, and other official agencies dealing with legislative matters, the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) is hereby specifically appropriated for the fiscal biennium beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one. One-half of said appropriation shall be paid during each fiscal year of said biennium, in equal quarterly instalments, on requisition drawn by the Auditor General. Warrants for such payments shall be drawn to the order of the Director of the Interstate Legislative Reference Bureau. Biennially hereafter an item of such amount as may be deemed necessary for the support of said bureau shall be inserted in the general appropriation law.

Payment.

Biennial item.

Section 3. On or before March first of each year, the Interstate Legislative Reference Bureau shall furnish to the Auditor General a printed accounting containing an itemized summary of receipts and expenditures for its preceding fiscal year, verified by oath or affirmation, accompanied by a verified copy of a report by one or more certified public accountants. Upon failure to file such accounting, the financial support hereby granted shall be withdrawn.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Highways to pay property damages heretofore occasioned as a result of the erection of garage and storage sheds; and making an appropriation therefor.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Secretary of Highways is hereby authorized to pay, from the Motor License Fund, the amount of damages or injury to private property occasioned as a result of the erection of garage and storage sheds.

Secretary of Highways.

Damages occasioned by erection of garage.

Section 2. Before paying any damages occasioned as provided in section one of this act, the same shall be submitted to and approved by the Attorney General, and, when approved, the amount thereof shall be paid by the State Treasurer, from the Motor License Fund, on the requisition of the Secretary of Highways.

Approval and payment.

Section 3. The sum of three hundred and thirty dollars (\$330.00) is hereby appropriated, from moneys in

the Motor License Fund, for the purpose of paying property damages under the provisions of this act.

When effective.

Section 4. This act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor.

AN ACT

Providing for the compilation, and printing and binding of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relative to soldiers, sailors, marines, and veteran organizations; providing for the distribution of the same; and making an appropriation therefor.

Soldiers, sailors and marines.

Compilation of laws relative to.

Appropriation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Legislative Reference Bureau shall make a compilation of all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relative to soldiers, sailors, marines, and veteran organizations; and the Department of Military Affairs shall cause the same to be printed and bound, and distribute a printed and bound copy thereof to each post, camp, or local branch of the Grand Army of the Republic, of the United Spanish War Veterans, of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, of the American Legion, and of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War. The State department commander of each of said veteran organizations shall furnish to the Department of Military Affairs the address of each post, camp, or local branch of their respective organizations.

Section 2. The sum of two thousand (\$2,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs, to be used for the purpose of paying the cost of the printing and distributing of the compilation provided for in the first section of this act.
