AN ACT

Providing for the compilation, and printing and binding of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relative to soldiers, sailors, marines, and veteran organizations; providing for the distribution of the same; and making an appropriation therefor.

Soldiers, sailors and marines.

Compilation of laws relative to.

Printing and distribution.

Department commander to furnish addresses.

Appropriation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Legislative Reference Bureau shall make a compilation of all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relative to soldiers, sailors, marines, and veteran organizations; and the Department of Military Affairs shall cause the same to be printed and bound, and distribute a printed and bound copy thereof to each post, camp, or local branch of the Grand Army of the Republic, of the United Spanish War Veterans, of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States, of the American Legion, and of the Disabled American Veterans of the World War. The State department commander of each of said veteran organizations shall furnish to the Department of Military Affairs the address of each post, camp, or local branch of their respective organizations.

Section 2. The sum of two thousand (\$2,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs, to be used for the purpose of paying the cost of the printing and distributing of the compilation provided for in the first section of this act.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Forests and Waters to cooperate with and to receive contributions from the Federal Government for forestry purposes; and providing for the use of such contributions.

Forest protection.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the Department

of Forests and Waters is hereby empowered and authorized to cooperate and enter into cooperative agreements with, and to receive contributions from, the United States government for the protection from fire, or other casualty, the development and the production of forests and forest producing lands. All contributions received hereunder from the United States government shall be paid into the State Treasury, through the Department of Revenue, and credited to the biennial appropriations to the Department of Forests and Waters for the same purposes for which the contributions were made.

Department of Forests and Waters authorized to enter into agreements with U. S.

Disposition of Federal contributions.

Section 2. This act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, and approval by the Governor.

AN ACT

Providing aid by the Commonwealth to free public non-sectarian county libraries; authorizing the Department of Public Instruction to provide books for demonstration purposes to encourage the establishment of such county libraries; and making an appropriation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That a system of State-aid for the maintenance of free public non-sectarian county libraries, in counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes, is hereby established. The annual aid by the Commonwealth to any such county library shall be measured by the amount appropriated annually by the county commissioners from county moneys for the maintenance of any such county library, and shall be determined as follows:

Counties of third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes.

Determination of annual aid.

The amount to be paid by the Commonwealth for the maintenance of any county library shall not in any year exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500), and such payment shall be made to the board of trustees in charge of any such free public non-sectarian county library.
