Appeal.

Section 3. That section three of said act is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3 amended.

Section 3. In case an order of removal is granted by any court of quarter sessions of the peace, under the provisions of this act, the court, in the same order, shall require the directors or poor-law officers of the place of settlement to pay the petitioners the cost of the proceedings, the expense of removing, and the proper charges for the relief of the poor person; [from the date of the notice first above provided for] all of which expense, cost and charges shall be ascertained and allowed by the court. If an order of removal is refused, the cost of the proceeding shall be paid by the directors or poor-law officers petitioning therefor.

AN ACT

To amend section nine of the act, approved the thirteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five (Pamphlet Laws, six hundred forty-four), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the solicitation of moneys and property for charitable, religious, benevolent, humane, and patriotic purposes," by increasing the fee to be charged by the Department of Welfare for certificates of registration.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section nine of the act, approved the thirteenth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five (Pamphlet Laws, six hundred forty-four), entitled "An act relating to and regulating the solicitation of moneys and property for charitable, religious, benevolent, humane, and patriotic purposes," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Department of Welfare.

Solicitation of moneys.

Section 9, act of May 13, 1927 (P. L. 644), amended.

Section 9. A fee of [two] *ten* dollars shall be paid to the Department of Welfare by every association, copartnership, corporation, or individual at the time of filing the original statement. All fees shall be paid by the department into the State Treasury *through the Department of Revenue*.

Fee.

Disposition of fees.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.
