AN ACT

Amending the act of June 26, 1970 (Act No. 93-A), entitled "An act making appropriations to the Department of Public Welfare and providing for certain allocations therefrom for the purpose of carrying out the Public Assistance Law for the year beginning July 1, 1970 and for the payment of assistance and expenses accrued or incurred prior to and remaining unpaid on June 30, 1970," increasing the appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of June 26, 1970 (Act No. 93-A), entitled "An act making appropriations to the Department of Public Welfare and providing for certain allocations therefrom for the purpose of carrying out the Public Assistance Law for the year beginning July 1, 1970 and for the payment of assistance and expenses accrued or incurred prior to and remaining unpaid on June 30, 1970," is amended to read:

Section 1. The sum of [three hundred eighteen million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$318,700,000)] *four hundred twenty-two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$422,300,000)*, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Public Welfare for the payment of assistance and administrative expenses for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1970 and for the payment of assistance and administrative expenses incurred prior to and remaining unpaid June 30, 1970, as provided in the act of June 24, 1937 (P.L. 2017), the act of June 24, 1937 (P.L. 2045) and the act of June 24, 1937 (P.L. 2051), April 23, 1941 (P.L. 20), May 10, 1951 (P.L. 279), July 13, 1953 (P.L. 431), August 9, 1955 (P.L. 323), the Public Welfare Code, The Fiscal Code, The Penal Code and the Public School Code of 1949. In addition to this amount, all moneys received from the Federal Government, or from any other source as contributions for this program, shall be paid into the General Fund and credited to this appropriation. The Department of Public Welfare shall allocate funds from time to time for administrative expenses of the several county boards of assistance, for such administrative expenses incurred by the department which are chargeable to such boards and for the payment of attorney's fees and court costs necessary for the proper conduct of the public assistance programs: Provided, That any rule or regulation adopted by the Secretary of Public Welfare during the fiscal year 1970-71 which adds to the cost of any public assistance program shall only be effective from and after the date upon which it is approved as to availability of funds by the Governor.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

A SUPPLEMENT

SB 352

To the act of March 4, 1971 (Act No. 3-A), entitled "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1970," itemizing appropriations required from the Motor License Fund for the proper operations of the several departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor License Fund moneys.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to The General Appropriation Act of 1970."

Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or appointed officers and employes of the Commonwealth, for contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper conduct of the duties, functions and activities for the purposes hereinafter set forth for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1970 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1970.

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For payment of interest and principal on State Highway and Bridge Authority bonds issued for highway purposes	33,963,000

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No more shall be expended from this item for such purpose or any of them than may be required to match an equal sum contributed by any political subdivision, or municipality authority of the Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by a political subdivision or municipality authority and the Federal Government as

provided in the act of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136), relating to Federal aid for airports.

For payment from the restricted revenue account for aviation fuel taxes for aviation operations including the payment of general expenses, supplies, printing and equipment, for the development and maintenance of State airports and the maintenance and repair of landing fields, intermediate landing fields, land field equipment, beacon sites, other navigation facilities, and the encouragement and development of civil aeronautics	1,822,000
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To the Treasury Department

For payment of principal and interest requirements on general obligation bonds issued for highway purposes	24,700,000
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For payment of the compensation of the Commonwealth's Loan and Transfer Agent for services and expenses in connection with the registration, transfer and payment of interest on bonds of the Commonwealth and other services required to be performed by the Loan and Transfer Agent	17,000

Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any other source as contributions to or payments for the programs provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the purposes and programs intended.

Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1970.
