AN ACT

To relinquish the purchase money and interest due the commonwealth, on a certain piece of land in Berks county, to the Hill Church.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the purchase money and interest due to the commonwealth on a certain piece of land, situate in Pike township, in the county of Berks, containing fifty acres and seventy-four perches, and the usual allowance of six per cent. surveyed on a warrant dated the twelfth day of August, Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty-seven, granted to Casper Grygher, George Ernest and Andrew Rodenheffer, and returned for the

use of the Hill Church, be and the same is hereby relinquished to the Lutheran and Presbyterian congregations of Pike township aforesaid, called the Hill Church; and the Secretary of the Land Office is hereby authorised and directed to issue a patent, free of purchase money, interest and fees, to William Walter, Adam Weller, Henry Gross and George Herbst, wardens of said congregations, and their successors, for said piece of land, in trust for the aforesaid congregations: *Provided*, That the title acquired under the aforesaid warrant shall appear to be in the said congregations, or in any person or persons in trust for them. **AN ACT**

Authorising loans from certain banks.

**SECT. 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the several banks of this commonwealth be and they are hereby required to loan to the commonwealth, the amount prescribed by the several acts of assembly, regulating the same, and the Governor be and he is hereby authorised and required to give notice to said banks, and negotiate said loans, upon the terms contained in said acts, and that the Auditor General and State Treasurer are hereby authorised to issue certificates of stock to said banks, for the amount thus loaned, upon the terms stipulated in the acts regulating said banks, and the amount thus loaned to be paid to and vested in the com-
