AN ACT

For the relief of Janet Mathison, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Janet Mathison, of the county of Philadelphia, widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act to authorise the Governor to incorporate a company to make a lock navigation on the river Schuylkill."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That to enable the president, managers and company of the Schuylkill navigation company to improve, strengthen, enlarge or alter their works, to add thereto or to make such additional or other locks, sluices, canals, dams, pools, tow-paths, or other devices whatever, as may seem to them necessary or expedient for rendering

the navigation as beneficial as possible, all and singular the powers, rights and privileges given to the said president, managers and company of the Schuylkill navigation company, by the act entitled "Act to authorise the Governor to incorporate a company to make a lock navigation on the river Schuylkill," or by any supplement to the said act, or by any other act or acts, if any there be, which may be deemed, construed or taken to expire or be determined on or after the eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty, be and the same hereby are declared to be continued and extended for a period of fifteen years, to commence and be computed from the said eighth day of March, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and thirty, to be held, enjoyed and exercised by the president, managers and company of the Schuylkill navigation company, during the said period of fifteen years, in like manner, and under the same liabilities and regulations, in all respects, as they heretofore have been or might have been held, enjoyed and exercised, or as if the said period had originally been thirty years, any thing in the said act entitled as aforesaid, or in any other act or acts, to the contrary notwithstanding: *Provided*, That this act shall not be so construed as in any way to affect the rights, interests and privileges now vested in the Union canal company of Pennsylvania.

Proviso.

Provisions relative to damages continued.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That all and singular the provisions contained in the said recited act, or in any supplement or supplements thereto, or in any other act or acts relating to compensation for damages claimed from the said company, which are now in force, be and the same hereby are continued and applied to work which may be done, or powers exercised under this act.

Time of publishing dividends.

SECT. 3. An' be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the half yearly dividends of the president, managers and company of the Schuylkill navigation company, shall be published on the first Monday in February, and the first Monday in August of every year, any thing in any act or acts to the contrary notwithstanding.
