

and be paid by the treasurers thereof, on warrants drawn in the usual way, and in proportion to the length of the road in each county respectively. The commissioners shall meet at Connellsville, in the county of Fayette aforesaid, on the first Monday of May next, or as soon thereafter as possible, and complete the said work as soon as practicable; and if any vacancies shall happen by the resignation or death of the commissioners, or any one of them, the Governor is hereby authorised to fill the vacancy or vacancies by a suitable appointment.

SECT. 6. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the commissioners aforesaid, to take from each and every person or persons owning lands along the road by them to be laid out, acquittances or releases from any claim of damage, upon condition that such road shall pass through the land of such person or persons: *Provided,* That the owner or owners of such lands agree so to release and acquit, and to file the same in the commissioners' office of the proper county.

## No. 15.

### A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorising the laying out of certain state roads," passed the sixteenth day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act entitled "An act authorising the laying out of certain state roads," passed the sixteenth day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred

and twenty-nine, as relates to the state road from the borough of Kittanning, in Armstrong county, to Meadville, in Crawford county, be and the same is hereby continued in full force and virtue, until the first day of December, A. D. eighteen hundred and thirty; and the time named in the act to which this is a supplement, for making out and depositing a draft of said road by the commissioners in the several offices therein named, is hereby extended to the said first day of December, eighteen hundred and thirty, and that the commissioners lay out the aforesaid road from Kittanning, through Lawrenceburg, to Evans' ferry, on French creek, near the Crawford county line.

## No. 16.

### AN ACT

Establishing an academy at Le Raysville, Pike township, in the county of Bradford.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That there shall be and hereby is established in Le Raysville, Pike township, in the county of Bradford, an academy for the education of youth in the useful arts, sciences and literature, by the name and style of "Le Raysville Academy."
