## No. 31.

### A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act to amend and consolidate with its supplements, the act entitled An act for the recovery of debts and demands not exceeding one hundred dollars, before a justice of the peace, and for the election of constables and for other purposes."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That whenever a constable of any township is deprived of the services of his deputy, by death, inability or refusal of said deputy to act, he the said constable shall have full power to make a deputy, with as full authority to act as if the said deputation had received the approbation of the court of general quarter sessions of the peace of the proper county, until the regular sessions of said court next ensuing the deputation, and so much of any act as is hereby altered is repealed: *Provided,* That the constable shall file with the clerk of the court of quarter sessions, a written copy of his deputation, and that the said deputation be approved by one of the judges of the court of common pleas of the county, and that the constable and his sureties shall be liable for the acts of said deputy, thus constituted, as in other cases.

Constables may appoint deputies until next court.

Proviso. Appointment to be approved of by one of the judges. Sureties liable.
