AN ACT

Extending an act, entitled "An act securing to mechanics and others payment for their labor and materials, in erecting any house or other building, within the city and county of Philadelphia," to the borough of Easton, Northampton county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the act entitled "An act securing to mechanics and others, payment for their labor and materials in erecting any house or other building, within the city and county of Philadelphia," passed the seventeenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and six, with its supplement, passed the twenty-eighth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eight, shall be and the same are hereby declared to be in full force and operation in the borough of Easton, in the county of Northampton, and mechanics and others in said borough shall have like remedy under said acts, as though they were herein enacted at full length.
