AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Joseph Walter and Catharine his wife.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into between Joseph Walter and Catharine his wife, now or late of the county of Union, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released, set free and discharged from the said marriage contract, and from all duties and obligations arising and derived thereby and therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in the bonds of marriage.
