A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to enable the Governor to incorporate a company for making an artificial road from Jersey Shore, in the county of Lycoming, to Coudersport, in the county of Potter."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Potter county be and they are hereby authorised to subscribe for so much of the stock of the company for making an artificial road from Jersey Shore to Coudersport, as may be necessary to complete the said turnpike road, according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, which stock so subscribed shall be the exclusive property of the said county: *Provided,* That the amount of the said subscription shall not exceed one hundred and forty shares of fifty dollars each, payable in four annual instalments.

Potter county may take stock.

AN ACT

Relative to the discharge of mortgages filed in the Land Office.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That when a mortgage has been or shall be given and filed according to law in the office of the Secretary of the Land Office, or lien endorsed on the patent for any tract or tracts of land, as security for the discharge of
