AN ACT

To enable Henry Russel, of Greene county, to sell and convey certain real estate.

Preamble. WHEREAS, William Crawford, late of Greene county, died intestate, leaving issue a number of children, some of whom are now dead, leaving children who are minors, and also leaving considerable real estate: *And whereas*, It has been represented that said real estate has been divided into four shares, and the heirs being severally called, have refused to accept the same at the valuation: *And whereas*, It is represented that the administrator has been ordered to sell the said land, but has declined or refused to comply with said order:

Therefore,

H. Russel authorised to sell estate of W. Crawford. **SECT. 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Henry Russel, of Greene county, be and he is hereby authorised to sell at public sale, upon such conditions as may be for the interest of all concerned, and convey in fee simple the real estate of William Crawford, late of Cumberland township, in the county of Greene, consisting of a tract of land situate in said township, either altogether or in parcels, according to the division made by the inquest, as may best suit purchasers, and to make good and sufficient deed or deeds for the same to the purchaser or purchasers, with the same effect as if the same had been sold by the administrator, under and by virtue of the said order: *Provided*, That before the said Henry Russel shall make sale as aforesaid, he shall give bond in such sum and with such sureties as the orphans' court of said county shall direct, conditioned for the faithful discharge of his duty, and proper application of the money arising from said sale: *And provided further*, That the sale of no part of said land shall be valid until the same shall have been reported to and approved by the orphan's court of said county.

Proviso. **To give security.** **2d proviso.** **Approval of sale.**

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the said Henry Russel shall be allowed as a com-

pensation for his services and expenses aforesaid, such sum as shall be approved by said court. Compensation.

AN ACT

To legitimate Province M'Cormick.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Province, the illegitimate son of Sarah M'Cormick, of the township of Connellsville, Fayette county, one of the children and heirs of William M'Cormick, deceased, be and he is hereby invested with the surname of M'Cormick, and from and after the passage of this act, under the name of Province M'Cormick, shall have and enjoy all the rights and privileges of a child born in lawful wedlock, and shall be able and capable to take, hold, inherit, pass and transmit all and any estate, real and personal, to all intents and purposes, as fully, effectually and completely, as if he had been the legitimate son of said Sarah M'Cormick.
