A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Kensington District of the Northern Liberties."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That all real estate within the Kensington district of the Northern Liberties shall be subject to the payment of the debts contracted by the commissioners of the said Kensington district of the Northern Liberties, for or by reason of any work done or materials furnished, for or in the pitching, curbing and paving any street or footway in front of said real estate, before any subsequent lien: *Provided,* That nothing herein contained shall in any wise impair or affect such liens as are existing at the time of passing this act.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the citizens of the Kensington district of the Northern Liberties, be and they are hereby authorised to elect two suitable persons for constables, in addition to the number now authorised by law, for said district, one to reside in the eastern and one to reside in the western division of said district.
