## AN ACT

Extending the time of holding the courts of common pleas in Bradford county, and changing the time of holding the courts in Tioga, M'Kean and Potter counties.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the several terms of the court of common pleas in and for the county of Bradford, shall hereafter continue two weeks when necessary for the furtherance of justice and finishing the business pending in the said court, commencing upon the several days and times now fixed by law, and the court of quarter sessions for the said county, may continue during the first week of each of the said terms, and venires shall issue for the summoning and returning jurors, as is directed by law with respect to all other counties where the term is required to be held or continued for two weeks.

Term to continue 2 weeks in Bradford, if necessary.

Quarter sessions first week.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the courts of quarter sessions and common pleas, to be held in and for the county of Tioga, shall commence and be holden on the Mondays next following the second week of the terms of the court of common pleas in Bradford county, to continue one week as at present if necessary.

Courts of Tioga,

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the courts of quarter sessions and common pleas to be held in the county of M'Kean, for the counties of M'Kean and Potter, shall commence and be holden on the Mondays next following the week on which the courts are held in the county of Tioga, and continue one week as at present if necessary.

M'Kean and Potter.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That so much of any act as is hereby altered or supplied, shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
