AN ACT

For the relief of Andrew Stough and other soldiers, and Sarah Lebo, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to John Schmidt, for use of Andrew Stough, of York county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty. §40 gratuity and annuity granted to A. Stough.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Christian Harring, of Bedford county, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, as a gratuity, and as full compensation for his revolutionary services. §40 gratuity to C. Harring.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay unto Philip Neitz, of Union county, and to Thomas Coleman, of Huntingdon county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each immediately, as a gratuity, and as full compensation for their revolutionary services. Same to P. Neitz and T. Coleman.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Frederick Hesser, of Schuylkill county, and to Jacob Sailor, of the city of Philadelphia, soldiers of the revolution, or to their orders, forty dollars each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars each, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty. §40 gratuity and annuity to F. Hesser and J. Sailor.

SECT. 5. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to William Long, of Delaware county, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, as a gratuity for his revolutionary services. 40 dolls gratuity to W. Long.

SECT. 6. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Sarah Lebo, of Lycoming county, widow of Henry Lebo, a soldier of the revolution, or to Same to S. Lebo.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act to endow the House of Refuge, and for other purposes," passed the second day of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-seven.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of Philadelphia, are hereby authorised and required to pay over to the treasurer of the House of Refuge, out of the county funds, in lieu of the annual payment of five thousand dollars, authorised and required to be paid by them in pursuance of the provisions of the third section of the act to which this is a supplement, the annual sum of ten thousand dollars, until the second day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, for the purposes mentioned and prescribed in and by the third section of the said act, the first payment for the year ending on the tenth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty, to be made at any time during said month, and each of the two succeeding payments to be made during the month of March, in the years eighteen hundred and thirty-one and eighteen hundred and thirty-two respectively.
