AN ACT

For the relief of sundry soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Balzer Spiece, of Berks county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty. \$40 gratuity and annuity granted to B. Spiece.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Jacob Keidler, of Philadelphia county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, forty dollars as a compensation in full for his revolutionary services, and as a gratuity. \$40 gratuity to J. Keidler.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Andrew Wallace, of Chester county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, a further annuity of twenty dollars, in addition to the annuity of twenty dollars granted to the said Wallace by the board of inquiry, in May, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen. \$20 added to annuity of A. Wallace.
