For the relief of the heirs of Paul Bonnel, a soldier of the revolution.

§200 grant-
ed to D. Mil-
likin, in trust
for heirs.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Dr. Daniel Millikin, of Hamilton, in the state of Ohio, two hundred dollars in trust and for the use of the children and heirs of Paul Bonnel, a soldier of the Pennsylvania line, in full compensation for a tract of donation land, which the said Paul Bonnel was entitled to for services rendered by him in the revolutionary war.
