AN ACT

For the relief of John Weller, a soldier, and Rosanna Shelly, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to John Weller, of Lancaster county, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty.

\$40 gratuity and annuity granted to John Weller.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to John Schmidt, for the use of Rosanna Shelly, of York county, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, forty dollars immediately and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty.

Same to J. Schmidt for use of R Shelly.
