AN ACT

To revive and continue in force the act entitled "An act to authorise the Governor to incorporate the Juniata bridge company, in the county of Huntingdon," and to extend the time limited by law for completing the Abington and Waterford turnpike road.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act entitled "An act to authorise the Governor to incorporate the Juniata bridge company, in the county of Huntingdon," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three, be and the same is hereby revived and continued in force, and the time for opening books for receiving subscriptions to the stock of said company so to be incorporated by the said act, is hereby extended until the first Tuesday of December, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one; and further, that the following named persons be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for receiving subscriptions to the stock of said company, viz. John Kerr, in the room and stead of William Kerr, junior, removed, and John Patton, esquire, in the room and stead of David Newingham, deceased.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the time limited by law for the completion of the Abington and Waterford turnpike road, be and the same is hereby extended to the twenty-fifth day of April, which will be in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.
