AN ACT

Authorising the supervisors of East Huntingdon township, in Westmoreland county, to assess and collect certain taxes.

WHEREAS, It has been represented that the auditors of East Huntingdon township, in a settlement made by them with Peter Pool, one of the supervisors of said township for the year eighteen hundred and twenty-five, there appeared to be a balance due to said Peter Pool, of one hundred and seventy-five dollars and forty-nine cents, which said balance yet remains unpaid :

Preamble.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the supervisors of East Huntingdon township, in Westmoreland county, be and they are hereby authorised and required to assess, collect and pay over to Peter Pool, his order or assigns, the amount of monies due to him, agreeably to the settlement made by the auditors of said township with him.
