

be able and capable in law to take, hold, inherit, pass and transmit all and every estate, real and personal, of whatever kind or nature soever the same may be at the death of his father, the said Cornelius, as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes, as if the said Harrison had been born in lawful wedlock: *Provided however,* Proviso.
That this act shall not operate so as to exempt the estate of the said Cornelius from the provisions of an act entitled "An act relating to collateral inheritances," but the estate of the said Cornelius shall be subject to the same, Not to interfere with collateral inheritance law.
in like manner as if this act had not been passed.

AN ACT

To enable Jacob Mawrer and Daniel Levan, guardians of the minor children of Henry Kline, to sell and convey certain real estate.

WHEREAS, It is represented that Henry Kline, late of Berks county, deceased, was seized at the time of his death of two certain parcels of land in said county, which is unimproved and yields no profit to the minor children of said deceased: Preamble.

Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jacob Mawrer and Daniel Levan, guardians of the minor children of Henry Kline, late of Berks county, deceased, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to sell at public sale, two certain parcels or pieces of land, situate in Earl township, county aforesaid, one containing ten acres and one hundred and fifty-five perches, and the other containing thirteen acres and nineteen perches, and to convey the same in fee simple, by a deed or deeds, to the purchaser or purchasers, which shall have the same force and effect as if the said minors Description of estate.

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled "An act relating to collateral inheritances."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That on the settlement of the accounts of county treasurers for moneys received by them on collateral inheritances, the Auditor General shall allow them for any sum by them collected and paid over to the State Treasurer, not exceeding one thousand dollars, for each dollar five cents, and above that sum for each dollar one cent, but in no case shall the commission on any estate exceed the sum of one hundred dollars: *Provided*, The same be paid within one month after the moneys in each case shall by them have been received, otherwise such allowance shall not be made: *And provided however*, That county treasurers now having such moneys in their hands, shall be allowed such commission, if the payment be made within one month from the passage of this act.
