## AN ACT

Authorising the State Treasurer to pay a certain sum of money to Daniel Moore, of Washington county.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, Henry Moore, of Washington county, paid more money to obtain a patent for a tract of land in the said county of Washington, than he should have paid, the inception of the title being a Virginia entry granted to James Hunter, at the rate of ten shillings sterling per hundred acres, and the said Henry Moore, to obtain his patent, was made to pay at the rate of ten pounds per hundred acres, making the difference of seventy two dollars on three hundred and six and one half acres, the quantity of land patented by the said Henry Moore, on the eighth day of December, one thousand seven hundred and eighty five: *And whereas*, There is no provision in law for refunding the money aforesaid, although it is evident that it was paid in mistake: *And whereas also*, Daniel Moore, the present owner of the land aforesaid, is entitled to all the rights, privileges, and immunities, connected with the said tract of land:

Therefore,

§72 appropriated.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Daniel Moore, of Washington county, or order, the sum of seventy two dollars, out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
