For the relief of William Clarke, administrator of George Donahu, deceased.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;* That the judges of the court of common pleas of Beaver county are hereby authorised and required to make such order relative to the payment of the costs which have accrued in the suit of Hugh Garvin against William Clarke, administrator of George Donahu, deceased, now depending in the special court of said county, as may be just and lawful.

AN ACT.

For the relief of sundry soldiers, and Sarah Lindsay and Elizabeth M'Mullin, the widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to John Kitts and Isaac Hanse, of Delaware county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars each as a gratuity, and as a compensation in full for their revolutionary services.

\$40 gratuity granted to J. Kitts and J. Hanse.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid;* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Sarah Lindsay, of Warren county, widow of a soldier of the revolution, or to her order,

\$40 gratuity and annuity to S. Lindsay

forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Elizabeth M'Mullen, of Centre county, widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, forty dollars as a gratuity, and as a compensation for the services of her late husband during the said revolution.
