## A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorising the laying out of certain state roads, in Greene, York, Cumberland and Schuylkill counties," passed March nineteenth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine, and an act authorising the laying out of certain state roads, passed sixteenth April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted, by the authority of the same,*

That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as authorises the laying out of a state road from the borough of Pottsville, opposite Greenwood furnace, in the county of Schuylkill, by the best and nearest route, through Port Carbon, passing Bell's saw mills, and Huntzinger's and Raush's grist mills, in Schuylkill county, to Mauch Chunk, in Northampton county, passed nineteenth day of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, and so much of the act as authorises the laying out of a state road, beginning at or near Keffer's tavern, in Schuylkill county, thence extending through Clark's valley, in Dauphin county, to intersect the Sunbury road at the lower end of said valley, passed the sixteenth day of April, eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, entitled "An act authorising the laying out of certain state roads," be and the same are hereby extended until the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and the chain-bearers, axe-men and staff bearers shall be allowed one dollar per diem each, any thing in the act to which this is a supplement to the contrary notwithstanding.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That George Rahn, of the county of Schuylkill, be and he is hereby appointed a commissioner in the room of Henry W. Conrad, and that so much of the act to which this is a supplement, which relates to the appointment of the said Henry W. Conrad, be and the same is hereby repealed.
