SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Christian Mosser he and he is hereby authorised and empowered to sell at public sale all the right, title and interest of the heirs of the said John Mosser and Henry Mosser, late of York county, deceased, in and to a certain tract of land, situate in Manor township, in the county of Lancaster, adjoining land of Adam Breneman, Abraham Hershe, Benjamin Hostetter, John Millinger and others, containing one hundred and six acres, and to convey the same in fee simple by a deed to the purchaser, which shall have the same force or effect as if the said Benjamin Mosser had accepted and conveyed the same: *Provided*, That before the said Christian Mosser shall make sale as aforesaid, he shall give bond in such sum and with such surety as the orphans' court of York county shall direct, conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties enjoined upon him by this act, and proper application of the money arising from said sale: *And provided further*, That before said sale shall be valid, it shall be reported to and approved by said court.

AN ACT

Authorising the administrator of Lewis H. Conover to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That William H. Sloane, administrator of Lewis H. Conover, late of Luzerne county, deceased, he and he

is hereby authorized to sell either at public or private sale, a certain tract of land of which the said Lewis H. Conover died, seized, situate in Shade township, in the county of Somerset, containing about nine thousand acres, and the said William H. Sloane is further authorised to make and execute a deed or deeds for the said tract of land to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, which deed or deeds shall in law and equity vest in the said purchaser or purchasers all the title and interest which the said Lewis H. Conover had and held in the same, at and immediately before the time of his death: *Provided*, That before the sale authorised by this act be made, the said William H. Sloane shall give bond to the commonwealth in such form, in such sum, and with such sufficient sureties, as the orphans' court of Luzerne county may direct, conditioned for the faithful execution of the trust hereby committed to him, and for the due and proper application of the proceeds of said sale, according to the order of the said court, and the true intent of the laws of this commonwealth: *And provided also*, Before the said sale shall be valid, it shall be approved of by the orphans' court aforesaid.
