AN ACT

Supplementary to the several acts incorporating a company to make a turnpike road, from the northern termination of the York and Conewago turnpike road, to the west end of the Harrisburg bridge.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That in addition to the number of shares which the Governor is authorised and directed to subscribe in behalf of this commonwealth to the York Haven and Harrisburg bridge turnpike road company, by the supplement passed the twenty fourth day of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-eight, the Governor is hereby authorised and directed to subscribe one hundred and twenty shares, amounting to six thousand dollars, to be paid by warrants drawn by the Governor on the state treasury, in the manner and on the conditions prescribed by the several supplements to the act incorporating said company.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the time for commencing operations on said road, be and is hereby extended for the term of one year from the passage of this act.
