

SECT. 10. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid;* That the said commissioners so appointed shall continue in office for the term of two years from the time of their appointment, and whenever any vacancy shall occur by reason of death, refusal to act, resignation or otherwise, it shall be the duty of said court, at any regular term or adjourned court, to fill such vacancy by a new appointment; and at the expiration of said term, or any future term of office, the said court is hereby authorised to appoint the said number of commissioners, with the same powers, for the further term of two years, and so from time to time until the affairs of said bank are closed.

AN ACT

For the appointment of Commissioners to run, mark and fix the division line between the township of Cattawissa, in the county of Columbia, and the township of Shamokin, in Northumberland county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania in general assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Elias Hoyt, of Luzerne county, and Joseph Whitacre of Lycoming county, and John Hayes, Esquire, of Union county, or any two of them, are appointed commissioners to do and perform the several things in this act directed, viz: the said commissioners, or any two of them, shall as soon as convenient, proceed to run, mark, and fix, the division line between the township of Shamokin, in the county of Northumberland, and the township of Cattawissa, in the county of Columbia, agreeably to the courses and distances following: Beginning at the mouth of Little Roaring creek, thence up said creek to the head thereof, thence on the ridge to the south branch

of Big Roaring creek, from thence up the said creek to Yarnall's Path, thence a south-easterly course to the county line: *Provided*, That the county commissioners of Columbia county shall first express in writing, their assent to the provision of this and the two succeeding sections of this act.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid*, That as soon as the said line is run, marked, and fixed, a draft thereof, with the courses and distances, shall be made and filed by said commissioners in the office of the clerk of the court of quarter sessions of Columbia and Northumberland counties.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid*, That the said commissioners shall be allowed two dollars each for every day necessarily employed in performing the duties mentioned in the first section of this act, together with a reasonable allowance for chain carriers, and markers, to be paid equally by the counties aforesaid, by orders drawn by the commissioners of said counties, on their respective treasurers, in the usual manner.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act authorising the Governor to incorporate the Northampton water company," and to continue in force an act entitled "An act to incorporate the York manufacturing company."
