

or improvements of the president, managers and company of the Delaware and Hudson canal company, or the agents of the said company, rendered less safe and convenient for navigation than they were before the said works and improvements were commenced.

*Resolved by the authority aforesaid,* That the said engineers or any one of them, be required to give reasonable notice, (by letters placed in the post office,) to the president and also to the agent of the said company, of the time when they will proceed to the examination aforesaid, and to examine, ascertain and report to the legislature, whether the said company have complied with the provisions of the third section of the act entitled "A supplement to the act entitled An act to improve the navigation of the river Lackawaxen," passed the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, which made it the duty of the said company, at each and every place where these works may be connected with the river Delaware, to erect a lock or locks and keep lock tenders, so as to provide for the ascent and descent of boats and craft as aforesaid, and without delay.

RESOLUTION.

Relative to the Delaware and Hudson canal company.

*Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met,* That the president, managers and company of the Delaware and Hudson canal company, be and they are hereby excused and exonerated from building the river lock in the dam across the river Delaware, for the present, and until they shall be required to do the same by an act or resolution of the legislature of Pennsylvania: *Provided,* That the said company shall by their proper officer or officers, within six months from this time, submit to the Governor of the state of Pennsylvania, their consent that the state of Pennsylvania may at

any time hereafter connect their Delaware canal with the canal of the said company, at such point or points at or near Carpenter's Point, and in such manner and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined on by two competent disinterested engineers, one to be appointed by the state and one by the company, and if they cannot agree, a third to be chosen by the two as above appointed, whose decision, or that of any two of them, is to be conclusive.

RESOLUTIONS

Relative to a revised code of Pennsylvania.

RESOLVE 1. *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in general assembly met,* That the Governor be and he is hereby authorised and required to appoint three competent persons, learned in the laws of this commonwealth, as commissioners to revise, collate and digest all such public acts and statutes of the civil code of this state, and all such British statutes in force in this state, as are general and permanent in their nature, allotting to such commissioners their parts respectively, as he shall deem fit: *Provided also,* That the said commissioners shall examine, correct and approve the separate labours of each.

RESOLVE 2. *And be it further resolved,* That it shall be the duty of the revisers to carefully collect and reduce into one act, the different acts and parts of acts which from similarity of subject ought to be so arranged and consolidated; to divest the said acts of all redundant phrases and useless verbiage; to distribute and arrange the several acts systematically, under proper titles, divisions and sections; to omit in the revision all such acts or parts of acts as shall have been repealed or supplied by subsequent acts, or which may have expired by their own limitation; to suggest to the legislature such contradictions, omissions or imperfections, as may appear in
