RESOLUTION

Relative to costs of Thomas Ross, Deputy Escheator General, and to the escheated estate of Dinah Henderson.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,
That the Auditor General be and he is hereby authorized and directed to settle and adjust the amount of costs legally due to Thomas Ross, late Deputy Escheator General for Bucks county, and the other officers, jurors and witnesses in the cases of the alleged escheat of the estates of Edward West and John Reynolds, deceased, and to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the amount found due in favor of said Thomas Ross, on his filing bond with one good surety for the faithful distribution of the money among the persons interested; and also, that the Auditor General be instructed to settle and pay as above the costs accrued in the case of the alleged escheated estate of Dinah Henderson deceased, late of Northumberland county.

Auditor General authorized to adjust acc'ts for costs in the cases of the estates of West and Reynolds.
Similar authority rel. to the estate of D. Henderson.
