AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of James S. Chambers and Rose Ann his wife.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into by and between James S. Chambers and Rose Ann Chambers his wife, late Rose Ann Crawford, both late of the county of Erie, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom as fully and effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.
