AN ACT

For the relief of Adam Weaver, a soldier of the revolutionary war, and Eve Gensimer, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Adam Weaver, of Westmoreland county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three. \$40 gratuity & ann. granted Adam Weaver.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Eve Gensimer of Lancaster county, widow of John Gensimer, a soldier of the revolutionary war; or to her order, forty dollars as a gratuity and compensation in full for the revolutionary services of her said husband. \$40 grat. to Eve Gensimer.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay, immediately, to Thomas Connelly, of Washington county, or to his order, the sum of forty dollars, in full for his military services. Same to Tho. Connelly.
