AN ACT

Authorizing the inhabitants of North Sewickly township, Beaver county, to elect three supervisors of the roads in said township.

SECT 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act it shall and may be lawful for the electors in North Sewickly township, Beaver county, to elect annually at their usual place of electing township officers, three qualified citizens for supervisors of the roads, subject to the same rules and regulations by which supervisors are by law regulated.

AN ACT

To enable the Governor to incorporate the Willardsburg turnpike road company.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That William Willard, junior, Elijah Depuy, and A. C.
