AN ACT

For the relief of Ebenezer Kerr, present coroner of Allegheny county and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Allegheny county, are hereby authorized and required to draw their warrants on the county treasurer in favor of Ebenezer Kerr, the present coroner of said county for the amount of jurors, constables and witnesses fees, paid on coroners inquests held by him in said county, at the rate of one dollar per diem for each juror in each case, and the constables and witnesses fees shall be taxed in conformity with the act of the twenty-second of February, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, regulating fees before justices of the peace and constables.

Comm'rs. to draw warrants in favor of E. Kerr for certain fees.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That from and after the first day of June next, it shall not be lawful for the coroner of the county of Allegheny to summon more than fifteen jurors upon any one inquest, and that the fees of such jurors so summoned and serving upon such inquest shall be fifty cents each per diem, which said fees shall be paid by the county commissioners to the jurors or their orders respectively, by warrant drawn by them in the usual way.

From 1st of June next coroner to summon not more than 15 jurors. Fees regulated.
