AN ACT

To revive and continue in force the chartered privileges of the Presbyterian congregation of Waynesburg, in Mifflin county, which have been lost by neglecting to choose trustees.

Election of
5 trustees
authorized.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Presbyterian congregation of Waynesburg, in Mifflin county, are hereby authorized to elect, as soon as practicable after the passage of this act, five trustees in the same manner as they are allowed to do under their charter of incorporation, who shall serve as such trustees until the second Monday in January next, at which time they may choose as they originally did under the charter aforesaid, and so on annually thereafter as directed by said charter.

Their acts
made valid.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the acts of the trustees so chosen shall be as good and valid in law as if there had not been any failure to choose as provided by said charter.
