A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act entitled An act supplementary to the act to incorporate and endow the Pennsylvania Institution for the deaf and dumb.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the first supplement to the act entitled "An act to incorporate and endow the Pennsylvania Institution for the deaf and dumb," passed the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-one, be and is hereby continued in force for the further term of five years, from and after the first day of April next, any thing in the fifth section of the said act of the eighth of February, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-one to the contrary notwithstanding: *Provided however,* That the time limited in the proviso of the said supplement shall be and the same is hereby increased to five years, and this extension of time shall operate as well in favor of the indigent pupils now in the institution as of those who may hereafter be received into it.

Proviso.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the time for making the report of the directors of the said institution to the legislature, shall be on or before the first Monday of February annually hereafter, and that so much of the seventh article of the "constitution and fundamental laws" of the said institution as requires the same to be made in the month of December, be and the same is hereby repealed.
