

Comm'rs. under act of March 30, 1831, to pay off loans from proceeds of sale of Walnut, Prune & Arch street prisons.

SECT. 9. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That it shall be the duty of the said commissioners appointed in pursuance of the act of Assembly passed the thirtieth of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, as aforesaid, for erecting the said prison, and their successors in office, and they are hereby expressly enjoined and required, so soon as they receive the moneys arising from the sale as well of the said Walnut street prison and Prune street apartment and the lots thereunto belonging, as also all that lot and piece of ground whereon the prison and debtors apartment are erected, commonly called the Arch street prison, bounded as is hereinbefore described, together with all the rights, privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging, to satisfy and discharge all sum or sums of money which they may have borrowed, as well by virtue and under the authority of the aforesaid act of the thirtieth March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty one, as by virtue and authority hereof, and all other debts by them contracted in pursuance of the act of the thirtieth March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and the provisions of this act.

Counties of Centre, Mifflin & Juniata transferred from Western to Eastern peniten. dist.

SECT. 10. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the counties of Centre, Mifflin and Juniata, from and after the passage of this act, be and the same are hereby attached to the Eastern district of Pennsylvania, so far as regards the punishment of offenders convicted in said counties.

AN ACT

To enable Thomas Laird, of the borough of Erie to perfect his title to out-lot number four hundred and twelve of the second section of the town of Erie.

Preamble. WHEREAS it has been represented that out-lot number four hundred and twelve of the second section of the town

of Erie was sold by the commissioners of sales of the lots of said town, at the original sales of said lots, and purchased by John F. Jones; *And whereas* it is also represented that said lot was in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifteen by the commissioners of the county of Erie, sold to Thomas Laird, of the borough of Erie, and that said Laird has been in possession of said lot ever since: *And whereas* the title to said lot cannot be perfected by reason of a defect in the power of the commissioner of sales: Therefore,

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioner of sales of the in and out lots of the town of Erie is hereby empowered and directed to issue and grant to Wilson Smith, of the town of Waterford, Erie county, a certificate of the sale of out lot number four hundred and twelve of the second section of the town of Erie, according to the entry and sale made to the aforesaid John F. Jones by the commissioner of sales of the town aforesaid, and the Secretary of the Land Office is hereby directed and required, on the application to him made, and on the production of such certificate of sale as aforesaid, to grant to the said Wilson Smith, his heirs or assigns, a patent for the aforesaid out lot number four hundred and twelve, on condition that the said Wilson Smith, his heirs or assigns, pay into the treasury of the commonwealth the usual office and patenting fees, and the purchase money due upon said lot, according to the terms of the entry and sale of said lot made by the commissioner of sales to John F. Jones, with interest, to be computed thereon from the eighth day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifteen: *Provided,* That nothing in this act shall be taken or construed to affect the right or title of any other person.
