## AN ACT

For the relief of Zachariah Closson, Jacob Booz, Henry Bloss and George Swetzer, soldiers, and Elizabeth Henry, widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to George Swetzer, of York county, or to his order; Jacob Booz, of Montgomery county, or to his order; and Zachariah Closson, of Montgomery county, or to his order, the sum of forty dollars each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

\$40 grat. and ann. granted to G. Swetzer, J. Booz, and Z. Closson.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer, be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Henry Bloss, of Northampton county, or to his order, the sum of forty dollars immediately, as a gratuity in full for his revolutionary services.

\$40 grat. to H. Bloss.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Elizabeth Henry, of Lancaster, the widow of a revolutionary soldier, or to her order, the sum of forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.
