AN ACT

For removing strata of rock from the bed of the Wallenpaupack river, in the counties of Pike and Wayne, and for other purposes.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the sum of three thousand dollars, to be appropriated to the purpose of removing strata of rocks from the bed of the Wallenpaupack river, in the counties of Pike and Wayne, near Wilsonville; and further, for the purpose of draining stagnant pools of water in the vicinity of Wilsonville.

\$3,000 appropriated.

SECT. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That Otto Kimble and Moses Killam, of Pike, and Enoch Woodward, of Wayne county, who are hereby appointed commissioners to expend that sum for the purposes aforesaid, shall each of them receive the sum of one dollar and fifty cents, to be paid by the counties of Pike and Wayne, for each day necessarily employed in the business aforesaid; and shall each, before entering on the duties aforesaid, give good and sufficient security for the faithful performance of the duties enjoined by this act, said bond and securities to be approved by the commissioners of the counties of Pike and Wayne.

Commissioners named to act under pay of counties of Pike and Wayne.
