## AN ACT

For the relief of George Keller, a soldier, and Louisa Osteer and Catharine Curry, the widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay George Keller, of the city of Philadelphia, a soldier, and to Louisa Osteer, of the county of Lancaster, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to their respective orders, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three. §40 grat. & ann. granted to G. Keller and L. Osteer.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay Catharine Curry, of Allegheny county, or to her order, forty dollars, as a gratuity, in full, for her late husband's services in the revolutionary war. §40 grat. to C. Curry.

## AN ACT

For the relief of James Kirk, Benjamin Watson, James Curry, Thomas Henderson, Thomas Clark and Adam Lead, soldiers, and Catharine Rehr, the widow of a soldier of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to James Kirk, of Ruck's
