A SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act establishing an Academy in the town of Wellsborough, in the county of Tioga."

Of the number of trustees.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the time for which the present board of trustees of the Wellsborough Academy were elected, the number of trustees shall be five, any three of whom shall constitute a quorum.

Their classification.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the trustees elected in pursuance hereof, shall, at their first meeting after such election, proceed to classify themselves by lot, so that their time shall expire respectively at the end of one, two, three, four, and five years; and that at the subsequent annual elections, only one trustee, to serve five years, shall be elected, except when a vacancy shall occur, which shall be supplied by an election for the unexpired time of the trustee, whose seat may, by any means, have been vacated.

Judges of election to decide cases of tie by lot.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That if one or more persons should have an equal number of votes, at any future election for trustees, that the judges of the election shall forthwith decide, by lot, which of said persons shall be elected.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act passed the twenty-second March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, entitled "An act relative to suits brought by or against corporations."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the service of any civil process upon the toll

gatherer of any incorporation, in the proper county, and next to the place where the damage or damages shall have been committed, shall be held as good and valid in law, as if served on the president, or other principal officer, or the cashier, treasurer, secretary, or chief clerk of any corporation, as aforesaid; and upon such service, the like proceedings shall be had, as is directed by the aforesaid act, to which this is a supplement: *Provided*, That where a suit shall be commenced, and the process served on the toll gatherer, it shall be the duty of the plaintiff, his agent or attorney, to cause reasonable notice to be given to some one of the officers of the company aforesaid, of the commencement of any such suit before trial and final judgment.

Process may be served upon toll gatherer.

Proviso. Notice to officer of company.

AN ACT

To authorise the State Society of the Cincinnati of Pennsylvania, to enjoy a larger income.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That notwithstanding the proviso contained in the fourth section of the act entitled "An act to confer on certain associations of the citizens of this commonwealth the powers and immunities of corporations, or bodies politic, in law," it shall be lawful for the corporation called and known by the name of "The State Society of the Cincinnati of Pennsylvania," to take, receive, and hold all, and all manner of lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises, and hereditaments, and any sum and sums of money, and any manner and portion of goods and chattels, given and bequeathed unto them, to be employed and disposed of according to the objects, articles, and conditions of the instrument upon which the
