

gatherer of any incorporation, in the proper county, and next to the place where the damage or damages shall have been committed, shall be held as good and valid in law, as if served on the president, or other principal officer, or the cashier, treasurer, secretary, or chief clerk of any corporation, as aforesaid; and upon such service, the like proceedings shall be had, as is directed by the aforesaid act, to which this is a supplement: *Provided*, That where a suit shall be commenced, and the process served on the toll gatherer, it shall be the duty of the plaintiff, his agent or attorney, to cause reasonable notice to be given to some one of the officers of the company aforesaid, of the commencement of any such suit before trial and final judgment.

Process may be served upon toll gatherer.

### AN ACT

To authorise the State Society of the Cincinnati of Pennsylvania, to enjoy a larger income.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That notwithstanding the proviso contained in the fourth section of the act entitled "An act to confer on certain associations of the citizens of this commonwealth the powers and immunities of corporations, or bodies politic, in law," it shall be lawful for the corporation called and known by the name of "The State Society of the Cincinnati of Pennsylvania," to take, receive, and hold all, and all manner of lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises, and hereditaments, and any sum and sums of money, and any manner and portion of goods and chattels, given and bequeathed unto them, to be employed and disposed of according to the objects, articles, and conditions of the instrument upon which the

said corporation is formed and established, or according to the by-laws thereof: *Provided*, That the clear yearly value or income of the messuages, houses, lands and tenements, rents, annuities, or other hereditaments and real estate of the said corporation, and the interest of money by them lent, shall not exceed the sum of three thousand dollars.

AN ACT

For the relief of John Overturff, Thomas Burk and George Cook, soldiers of the revolution.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Overturff, of the county of Fayette, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Thomas Burk, of the county of York, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to George Cook, of Greene county, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, forty dollars, as a gratuity, for his revolutionary services, and an an-
