AN ACT

For the relief of John Overturff, Thomas Burk and George Cook, soldiers of the revolution.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Overturff, of the county of Fayette, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Thomas Burk, of the county of York, a soldier of the revolution, or to his order, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

AN ACT

To change the names of Sebastian Gundt, George Henry Gundt, and Benjamin Gundt, of the county of Northampton, and John George Gundt, of the county of Bucks.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That Sebastian Gundt, George Henry Gundt, and Benjamin Gundt, of the county of Northampton, and John George Gundt, of the county of Bucks, be, and they are hereby respectively authorized to change their names from Sebastian Gundt, to that of Sebastian Goundie; and from George Henry Gundt, to that of George Henry Goundie; from Benjamin Gundt, to that of Benjamin Goundie; from John George Gundt, to that of John George Goundie;—and they shall henceforth be called and known by the name of Sebastian Goundie, George Henry Goundie, Benjamin Goundie, and John George Goundie, and by the same names shall be able and capable in law, respectively, to sue, and be sued, grant and receive, and do all other legal acts, as effectually, to all intents and purposes, as they could have done by their former names, if no change had been made therein.
