A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act entitled "An act for the promotion of agriculture and domestic manufactures."

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the act entitled "An act for the promotion of agriculture and domestic manufactures," passed the sixth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty, and the provisions of the second section of a supplement thereto, passed the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, are hereby re-enacted and extended for the further term of five years from and after the sixth day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, so far as respects the counties of Washington and Greene.

Certain provisions of former acts extended 5 years.

AN ACT

Providing for the inspection of Spirituous Liquors in the boroughs of Columbia and Washington, in the county of Lancaster, and in the town of Wrightsville, in the county of York.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Governor of this Commonwealth be, and he is hereby directed, on or before the first day of May next, to appoint and commission a fit person, who shall reside in the borough of Columbia, to be gauger and inspector of domestic distilled spirits in the said borough of Columbia, and county of Lancaster; and also, a fit person, who shall reside in the borough of Washington, in said county, to be gauger and

Governor to appoint inspectors for Columbia and Washington.
