

and also to ordain, establish and put in execution such by-laws, ordinances and regulations as shall appear necessary and convenient for the government of the said corporation, not being contrary to this charter, or the constitution and laws of the United States or of this commonwealth, and generally to do all and singular the matters and things which to them it shall lawfully appertain to do for the well being of the said corporation, and the due management and ordering of the affairs thereof: *And provided further*, That the objects of the society shall be confined to the alleviation of the miseries of public prisons; the improvement of prison discipline, and the relief of discharged prisoners.

AN ACT

To confirm Richard Ashhurst and George Morris in the title to certain real estate in the city of Philadelphia.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That Richard Ashhurst and George Morris, and their heirs respectively, be, and they are hereby confirmed in the title of certain real estate, in the city of Philadelphia, consisting of parts and parcels of certain lots which were purchased by the president, directors and company of the Bank of North America, at sheriff's sale, and which the said Bank, by deed dated the twelfth day of April, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and ten, recorded in the office for recording of deeds, &c. for the city and county of Philadelphia, in deed book I. C. number seven, page three hundred and eighty-nine, conveyed to Timothy Abbot and Hanson Waters, in fee to the intent and so far forth, that the said title shall at no time hereafter be questioned by or on behalf, or in the name of this commonwealth, for or by reason of any defect or alleged defect of power in the said Bank of North America to purchase, hold or convey the said real estate; and that the said Richard Ashhurst and George Morris, and their heirs respectively, shall hold the said real estate, and may dispose of the same with the like effect as if the said Bank of

North America had been authorized by its charter to purchase and hold, and convey the same to the said Timothy Abbot and Hanson Waters.

AN ACT

To authorize the canal commissioners to settle and adjust the claims of John Evans, a contractor for the construction of the Swatara aqueduct.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby directed to settle and adjust the claims of John Evans, a contractor for the construction of the Swatara aqueduct, in such way and manner as to them may appear equitable and just, which said settlement and adjustment shall be final and conclusive; and if any balance is found to be due the said John Evans, the Auditor General is hereby authorized to audit the same, in the way and manner other claims are presented and audited.*
