AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of Jehu Hatfield and Harriet his wife.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into by and between Jehu Hatfield and Harriet his wife, be and the same is hereby made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely, as if they had never been joined in marriage.

AN ACT

To authorize Jacob Kern, administrator of the estate of George Palmer, deceased, to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jacob Kern, administrator of the goods and Unimproved chattels, rights and credits of George Palmer, late of the lands. county of Northampton, deceased, be, and he is hereby authorized to sell and convey all the unimproved lands of which the said George Palmer died seized and possessed, at public or private sale, as the said Jacob Kern shall deem most conducive to the interests of the heirs of said George Palmer, deceased, and to make and execute good and sufficient deeds to the purchasers, as well for the lands sold previous to the passage of this act, as well as for those to be sold in pursu-
